Lindsay Henke is a clinical social worker and maternal mental health therapist in Minneapolis, MN. She provides individual and group psychotherapy in private practice setting in reproductive trauma, infertility, perinatal and infant loss, and the pregnancy that follows along with postpartum anxiety and depression mental health treatment. She is also the Founder and Executive Director of Pregnancy After Loss Support (PALS), which is dedicated to ensure that every mom and her partner who is experiencing pregnancy after loss is able to find support and connection among both peers and health care professionals.
